

Week 2: "Rock Bottom" Discussion Questions



To see God's goodness in the past, we must leave behind any idols we may be putting our faith in and trust God's goodness even when circumstances seem hopeless. When Habakkuk questioned God about evil and injustice this was God's response: "Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked; but the righteous will live by their faith." (Habakkuk 2:4)

Discussion Questions:

- What did it mean for Habakkuk and his people to "live by faith?"
- Describe a time in your life when the circumstances seemed hopeless but you "lived by faith." How did you see God's goodness revealed through these circumstances? How did it affect your relationship with God? With others?
- Read Habakkuk 2:18-20. What kinds of "idols" do many people look to for their rescue today?
- Describe areas in your life where you are tempted to trust in "idols" rather than God?
- How will you "live by faith" in those areas of your life? How can this group help you?

Moving Forward:

Ask God for eyes to see His goodness in every area of your life, wisdom to identify and reject any "idols" you may be putting your trust in today, and the strength to "live by faith" and trust Him even when things look hopeless.
